

County Council Regular Meeting: June 27, 2017

I. Introduction.

The meeting was called to order at 3:02 pm by Councilman Brady and ended at 3:24 pm. All Council members were present.

II. Antecedents, Announcements and Public Comment.

None.

III. Business Transacted.

Among the resolutions adopted after 1st, 2nd, or 3rd Reading were the following:

- Amending the 2016/2017 biennial operating budget
- Approving an amendment to a collective bargaining agreement between Cuyahoga County and the Cleveland Building and Construction Trades Council
- Awarding to Diversified Infrastructure Services, Inc. an amount, not to exceed \$2.3 million, for cleaning and televising sewers
- Emergency repair of a Shaker Boulevard culvert in an amount not to exceed \$200,000
- Awarding Euthenics, Inc. an amount, not to exceed \$788,987, for design engineering services for replacement of Memphis Road bridge
- An agreement with the City of Cleveland/Cleveland Municipal Court for an amount not to exceed \$1.9 million for the public defender's office
- Awards, not to exceed \$3 million, for residential treatment services to various providers
- Authorizing amendments to contracts with various providers for the teen pregnancy prevention program

Among the resolutions referred to committee:

- Confirming the appointment of various individuals to serve on the Tax Incentive Review Council
- Confirming the reappointment of Michael Procuik to serve on the Planning Commission
- Adopting the annual tax budget
- Authorizing an Economic Development Fund Business Growth and Attraction Loan, not to exceed \$1.5 million, to Rinicella 4, LLC for the Darko Project
- Authorizing an amendment to an agreement with City of Cleveland for crime lab testing services

A number of resolutions were pulled from the agenda and held for a later date.

- Authorizing \$9.25 million for purchase of the Cleveland Police Headquarters on Ontario
- Awarding an amount, not to exceed \$11.6 million, for runway improvements at Cuyahoga County airport
- Authorizing an Economic Development Fund Business Growth and Attraction Loan, not to exceed \$2 million, to Charter Manufacturing Co., Inc.
- Authorizing an amendment to a contract with Douglass & Associates Co., LPA for services to the County regarding collection services in an amount not to exceed \$2.2 million
- Authorizing an agreement with the City of Cleveland for jail services
- Authorizing a lease agreement with the City of Bedford for jail services
